

Funding Opportunities

For many years there have been travel bursaries and other funding opportunities available to APEM members.

To date, there have been very few applications, we clearly need to improve our advertising of this. The most recent funding example was a donation towards the amazing work of the soft landings team.

We would like to invite people to submit applications for either a travel bursary or for money towards a national project.

The applications can be made by any APEM member.

The applications should be a maximum of 1000 words. Applications would be reviewed by the APEM executive committee. The APEM committee would reserve the right to not allocate funding to any applications, or to provide funding to more than one recipient. Applications must include:

Applicant name and institution

Clear outline of how the study/ project benefits PEM

Clear outline of what any funding will be spent on.

We plan to have 2 rounds of applications. We plan to have the closing dates before both the RCEM and RCPCH conferences and will announce the successful applicants at those events. We would expect the successful applicants to present information about the funding and how it has been of benefit at the following years conference.

We would not expect to make payments of more than £2000 to one individual/ project.

Successful applications would be expected to include evidence of applications to other funding sources and showing how the project will benefit the wider PEM community.
